

ATTENTION ALL CLIENTS!

All persons are to remain at their place of residence, except to engage in Essential Activities during which time they must practice social distancing and handwashing requirements. This order was put into effect to protect members of the public from avoidable risk of serious illness and death resulting from the spread of COVID-19.

While inside this shelter/residential program:

- All individuals must stay at least six (6) feet from others, to the extent feasible (social distancing).
- All individuals must regularly and frequently wash their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or regularly use hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol.

Any individuals experiencing symptoms of respiratory illness, including fever or cough MAY NOT enter this facility.

Should you violate any of the directives of this order –placing others at risk, you may not be allowed to return to the shelter.
